

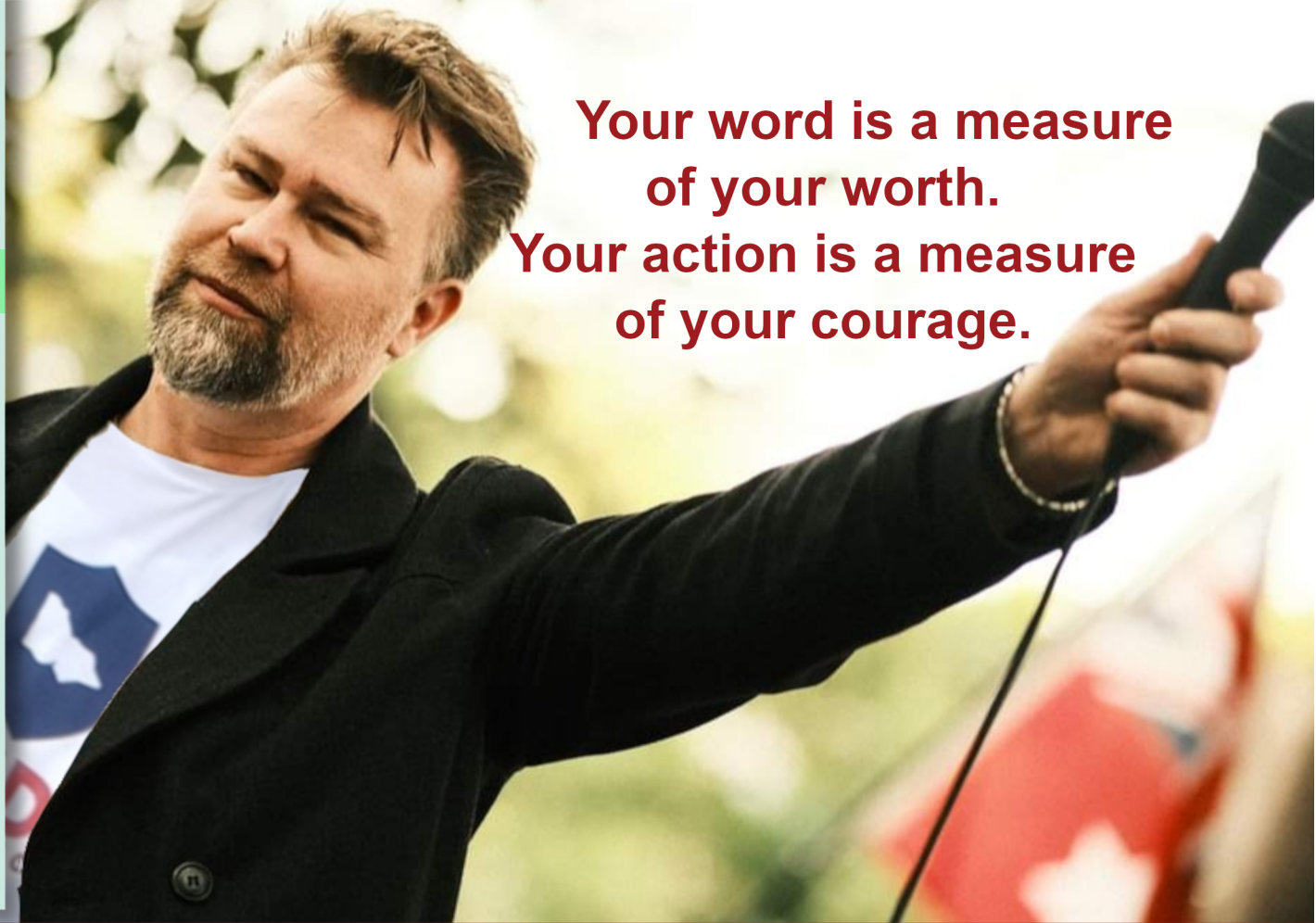

Valuing the Individual, Families, Small Business & Community

Roads - effective public transport & road maintenance & safety eg. fixing Five Ways Intersection.

Responsibilities - government responsibility to serve & govern (not rule) only in the interests of the people.

Freedom of speech - the right to express opinion; the requirement to be tolerant..

Keep Cash - ensure cash is not removed as legal tender to support many causes, such as schools, the homeless, charity etc. as well as families & businesses.
